

PJ's Bucket Bag – August 2018

Project Info

Supplies needed:

Baby Lock Jet Air Threading Serger
In good working order

Power cord and Foot control

Optional – Standard sewing machine

4 Spool Standard Serger thread – Madiera or
Maxi Lock (match fabric)

2 Spools 12 weight Cotton or Polyester thread

#90/14 Topstitch needle

Large eye Blunt tip needle

Standard or Clear Foot

Blind Hem Foot (H)

Piping Foot (P5)

Fabric Marker that will show well on your fabric

General sewing supplies

Owner's Manual

Quick Reference Threading guide

Accuquilt GO! Big Cutter

Accuquilt GO! Die – Circle-2", 3", 5"

Accuquilt GO! Die - Big Circle - 4", 6", 7", 8"



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Materials Needed –

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard = 1 of each size

$\frac{3}{8}$ yards = 1 - 8" size

$\frac{3}{8}$ yard = 1 – 7" size and 1 – 5" size

$\frac{3}{8}$ yard = 2 – 6" size

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard = 2 – 5" size

6" - $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 1" Grosgrain Ribbon

#5 Zipper by the Yard with pulls

Recommended Fabric

Double faced Quilted Fabric

This is PJ's version of a classic Bucket Bag – While I was setting up the Thread Catchers serger club project, it occurred to me that the Diagonal Zippy bag from a few months back would be cute with a round bottom, so here it is!!! PDF patterns for the circles are included if you don't have the Accuquilt dies

PROJECT PICTURE



There are 4 sizes:

8" round bottom is 10" tall, 7" round bottom is 9" tall, 6" round bottom is 8" tall
and the 5" round bottom is 7" tall.



Height options

5" size with 7" height on the left and 10" height on the right

The taller height makes for a great little cross body when you don't want to carry a full size bag!
