Supplies needed:

Embroidery machine in good working order
Power cord
4 x 4 hoop and 5 x 7 hoop
80/12 Embroidery Needle
Polyester Embroidery threads
Embroidery bobbin
Floriani's Medium Tear Away Stabilizer
1 pair - ½" or ¾" neodymium disc magnets
General sewing supplies
Owner's Manual

Recommended Fabric:

Quilt Weight Cotton or Blend



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Materials needed:

Small – 3 pieces of fabric 4 ½" x 1 ¾"

Large – 3 pieces of fabric 5 ¼" x 2"

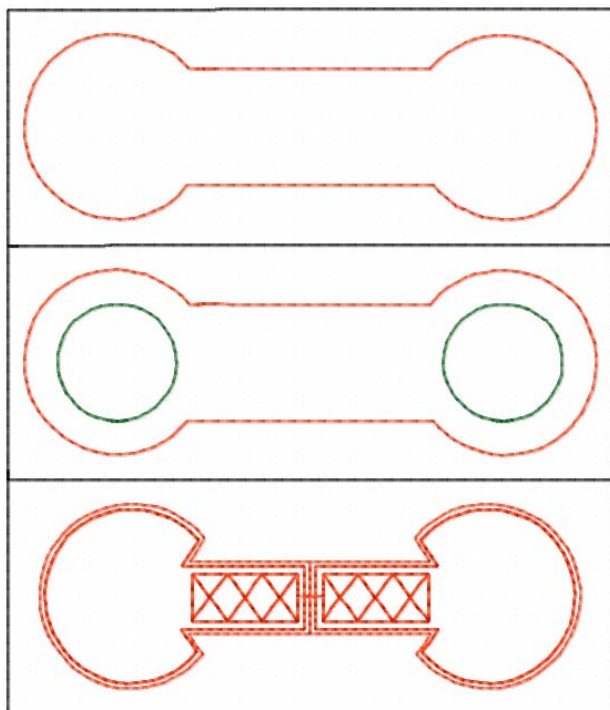
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project this month are Bud Buddies – I saw something like this online and thought it was a good idea. Bud Buddies are a simple, multiple hooping, "In the Hoop" project to help control the cord from your ear buds. There are magnets in both ends so you can fold the "Buddie" over the edge of your shirt or jacket, then loop the cord through the button holes and the cable of your ear buds will be held in place. The small size is perfect for light weight fabrics, like T-shirts and the large size works well for sweatshirts or sweaters.

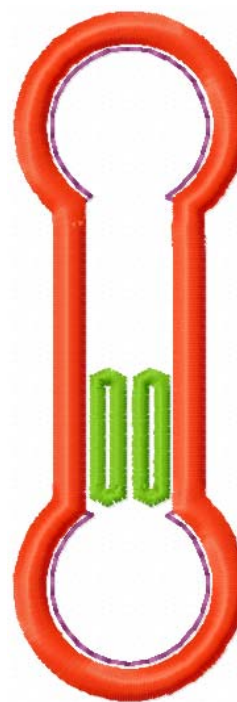
The ends are held together with a pair of neodymium disc magnets – ½" for the small and ¾" for the large – The magnets I used are 1/16" thick – I got mine at NW Magnet – here is their info

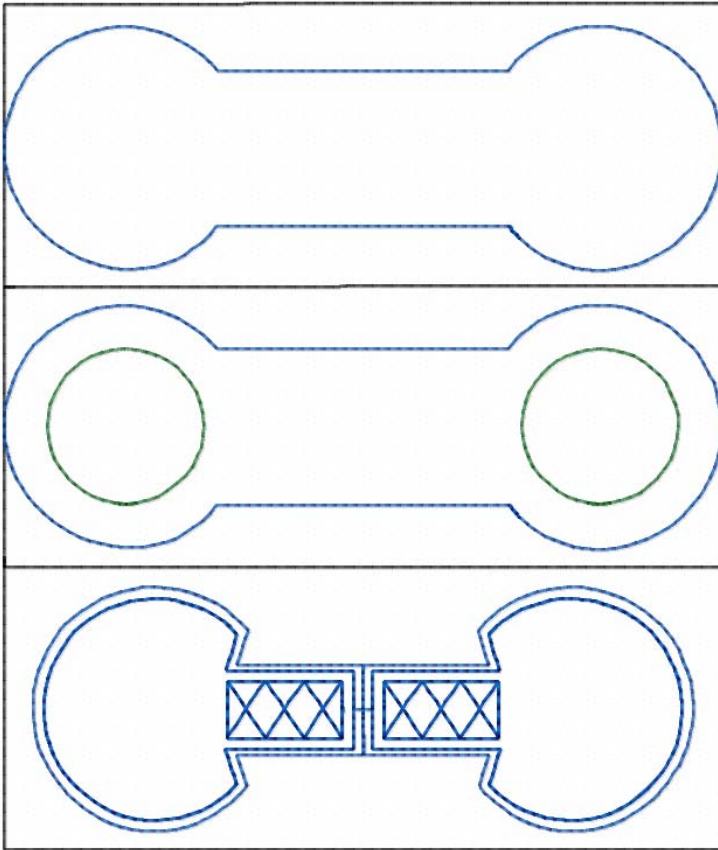
CLUB DESIGNS – PICTURES NOT TO SCALE



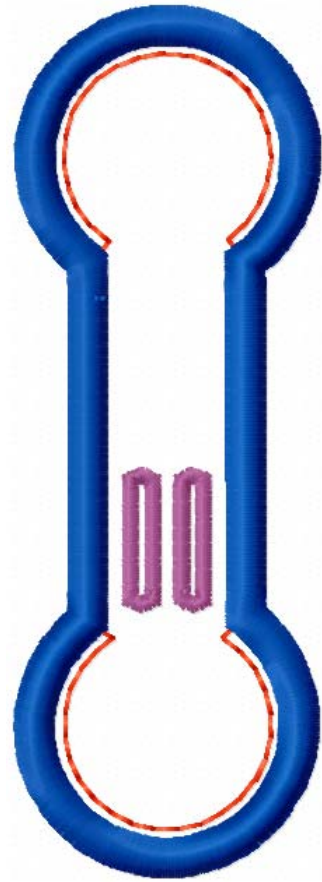

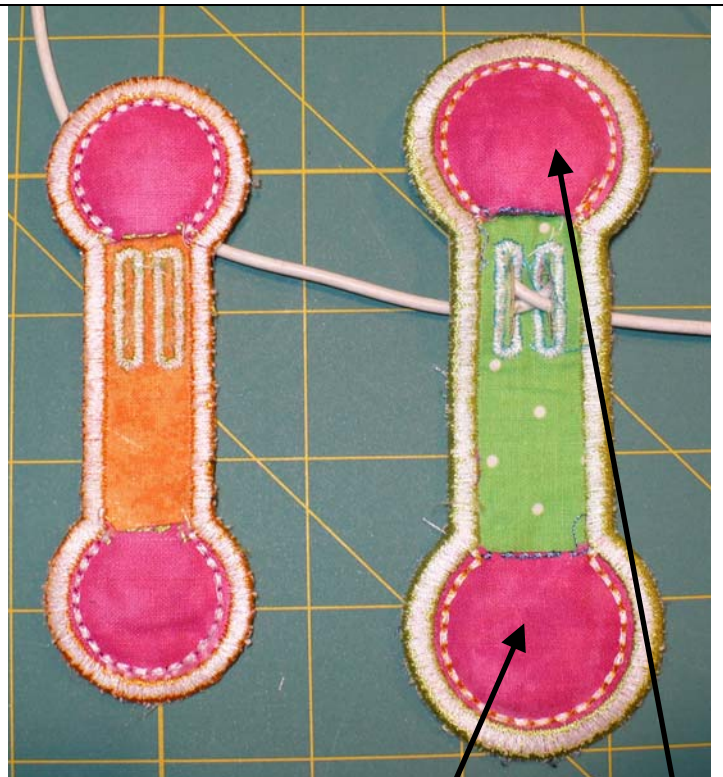
