Recommended Fabric:

Back – quilt weight cotton – prints work best

Front - quilt weight cotton



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Materials Needed – for 1 block

Base Blocks – 2 - 9" squares – muslin or No Show Mesh


Back Block - 9" square

Front – all cut parts from MBP

Warm and Natural or White Batting –

7 7/8" square

Here are the parts you'll need for the On Point Block



1 - Back Block	2 – Bottom Base Muslin	3 – Top Base No Show Mesh
6 - Center Front	5 - Corners	4 - Batting

LOADING THE MONSTER BLOCK MAKER

Place the muslin base fabric flat on the table


Place the Monster Block Maker over the top of the fabric

Center the cut out over the fabric

Set the Monster Block Maker down onto the bottom base fabric



Place the batting on top of the bottom base fabric



Place the Top base No Show Mesh over the batting

Working from the center out, firmly press the top base fabric and bottom base fabric to the double stick tape

Attach the hoop to the machine

Stitch Color #15 – the basting border









Right Side Up Tacking stitch for fabric 1


Finger press the seam and flip fabric #2 into place Smooth out the fabric Stitch color #4 Piece Finishing Stitch Tacking stitch for fabric 2 4. Place glue at the seam for fabric #3





Finger press the seam and flip fabric #4 into place Smooth out the fabric Stitch Color #8 Piece Finishing Stitch Tacking stitch for fabric 4 8. Place glue at the seam for fabric #5 Place fabric #5 – right side face down Stitch Color #9 Right Side Together Folding stitch for fabric 5 9.

Place glue at fabric #5



Finger press the seam and flip fabric #5 into place

Smooth out the fabric

ADDING THE BLOCK BACK AND EMBELLISHMENT

Lighty spray the wrong side of the fashion fabric back block

Add the back fabric to the back side of the hoop

Stitch Color #11 – the basting border - This will attach the back to the block

Note: If you'll be doing a Whole Cloth Back, skip this step



Stitch colors #12, 13 and 14 – the embellishments - Skip color #15 Congratulations your On Point block is complete!!! **NOTES**
